As background, here is our current Mission Statement...

Believing in Jesus as Savior, We gather together to: Celebrate God, Love one another, And grow as disciples – So we can change the world.



Let's start with some descriptions/definitions.

*Mission is what we shoot for. Definable objective

*Vision is what we root for. Dream statements

A good mission statement should:

*Answer the question "what are we here for?"

*Answer the question "what does God want the church to do?"

*be short and clear

*give focus and definition to our work

*be specific so results can be measured

*Help clarify common purpose

*Don't let it be controlling or manipulative

*A good statement unites people around a common purpose

*A definition of your church

*States why your church exists

*Start with the why and move to the what. (why=mission, what=vision)

*Start at the center – Jesus Christ – and work out into the world.
